

<sup>2</sup>Pre-tax Net Dividend Yield for the period 10/1/2025–12/31/2025 was 9.1%. Pre-tax Net Dividend Yield on Capital Employed is estimated at 9.25%, calculated excluding the period prior to October 10, as the Fund significantly increased in size during that time (approximately 80% growth). This expansion was a key factor driving performance toward the 9.0–9.5% target range for Q4 2025.

## CURRENT PRETAX NET DIVIDEND YIELD, ANNUALIZED<sup>3</sup>




<sup>3</sup>As of December 2025, the pre-tax net dividend yield stood at 9.10%, while the yield on capital employed remained consistently above 9.25% over the past three months, reflecting the efficient portfolio allocation of increased capital. Fund's performance follows an upward trend since July 2025 and in line with the target 9.0–9.5% performance range for Q4 2025. Enhanced performance results were primarily driven by effective portfolio allocation decisions and the August hurdle rate adjustment, the impact of which was fully reflected from Q3 2025. During Q4 2025 Fund has delivered a significant AUM increase (USD 18.3M growth), bringing total AUM to USD 25 million. In response to increased investor demand, the fund's target size was increased to 60 million in December, with larger fund size potentially supporting broader investor base, enhanced liquidity, increased portfolio diversification and economies of scale. As the Fund approaches its original target size of USD 30 million, yield adjustments related to the declining interest-rate environment are expected to become more evident over time, with the overall impact moderated by contractual interest-rate lags, consistent with prior rate-decline cycles—particularly given the Fund's relatively higher allocation to fixed-to-term interest-rate investments (77%).

<sup>4</sup> Pretax Net Dividend Yield represents annualized cumulative net yield since last dividend distribution calculated after management and performance fees, but before dividend/capital gain taxes up to 5%. Pretax Net Dividend yield is calculated as income throughout the period divided by share book-value, same as NAV per share % change throughout the period, annualized.

<sup>5</sup>The Fund's results include unaudited financial data and preliminary estimates since October 1, 2025. October 2024 data is excluded since fund started its operations on October 18, 2024.
